



Attend an upcoming Public Forum

You may be aware that The New York State Office for the Aging (NYSOFA) has commissioned a study of the feasibility of creating an Office of Community Living (OCL).

The legislation (chapter 57 (S2007-B/A3007-B)) requires NYSOFA to seek public input about the creation of an Office of Community Living with the goal of providing improvements in service delivery and improved program outcomes that would result from the expansion of community living integration services for older adults and persons of all ages with disabilities.

An independent survey was sent to stakeholders, consumers and providers for input.

The next step is a presentation of the survey data at a series of public forums and an opportunity to gather additional input, guidance and recommendations from stakeholders.

It is critical that all stakeholders be part of this process. Attend an upcoming forum, become fully informed and share this important information with your network, consumers and aging partners.
