5. Suicide Prevention among Older Adults

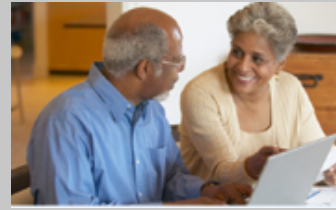

Program Information Needed to be Successful Registering & Enrolling in Program:

1. Participation in this program is optional and eligibility is at the discretion of the AAA Director . NOTE: There are no Program Instructions (PI) written by NYSOFA for this program.
2. **AAA Training Liaison Identified** - each AAA Director will serve as the Training Liaison between your agency and CADER. The AAA Director has the option to designate another person to serve as the Training Liaison and should notify

CADER if you'd like to appoint someone other than yourself as the Training Liaison for this program. Make sure to include the person's name, email address and phone

number in this email. ([CLICK HERE TO EMAIL CADER any change regarding who the Training Liaison will be for this program - please include name and email address](#))

3. **Registration for the AAA Agency and Registering Eligible Participants** - This is a 2 step registration process:
 1. The AAA Training Liaison will register their agency to participate in the program by submitting the [AGENCY SIGN UP FORM](#). This form will not only register your AAA it will also identify the AAA staff who are eligible to participate in this training. Please make sure to include the participant's name and full email address. Please know that a participant's email address must be shared with CADER and inputted into their system prior to the participant enrolling in the program.
 2. It is strongly recommended that the [Agency Sign Up Form](#) be submitted by Thursday, March 31st if a person anticipates registering/enrolling in the Behavior Health Program starting April 4th.
